SUBJECT-SLAUGHTER OF COW PROGENY

Sir

It is quite unfortunate that being in power in full majority for last two years in Odisha the Govt has not taken any stringent step to prohibit cow slaughter and cow challan which is done in one week AFTER BJP CAME TO POWER IN WEST BENGAL AND THE NEWS WAS BROADCASTED 24/7 IN MAINSTREAM MEDIA AS WELL AS YOUTUBERS.

It is pertinent to mention that although the Government has declared for a complete ban on cow slaughter and cow challan both through print media and electronic media it is unfortunate that it has not been executed and in force which resulted in massive cow challan for cow slaughter in Keonjhar, Mayurbhanj, Bhadrak, Khurda etc and there were raid by both police and ED and huge amount of wealth recovered from the cow mafia recently.

It is admitted that the district administration has miserably failed in checking cow challan for cow slaughter in which the local police, concerned district collectors and SPs along with RTOs are directly involved in this and fully responsible for cow challan for cow slaughter for quid pro quo as such huge number of huge animals are collected and transported through huge containers in public place, public

view and on public road could not be noticed by the law enforcement agencies is unbelievable and it smells fishy for vote bank politics.

It is also strange that such containers pass many toll gates, forest check posts and police checking both on NH and SH but government authorities could not locate the illegal cow challan for cow slaughter in the container sounds strange and why the containers were not opened and verified by the authorities at the concerned check post needs to be explained.

The government is too busy for sending notice for not renewing PUC and putting fine of Rs 10,000/- for the default for every to and fro through the toll gate but it only puts Rs 50/- as fine for cow slaughter and there cannot be more ridiculous act than this and it should be made more than the fine for PUC at least.

The government should consider the suggestions made below as it has not considered the directions of OHC in my PIL to take into account the steps taken by other states like UP, Rajasthan, Gujarat etc for prevention of cow challan for cow slaughter.

1. DECLARATION BY THE OWNERS OF THE COW PROGENY THAT THEY DON'T EAT BEEF AND REGISTER BIRTH DEATH AND SALE OF THEM WITH LOCAL PS AND MUNICIPALITY TO PREVENT ROOT CAUSE OF COW SLAUGHTER AND COW CHALLAN BOTH INTERDISTRICT AND INTERSTATE
2. MAKE THE LOCAL PS. SP, DM AND RTO HELD RESPONSIBLE DIRECTLY FOR SUCH COW CHALLAN FOR COW SLAUGHTER UNDER THEIR JURISDICTION
3. WEALTH RECOVERED FROM SEIZURE OF PROPERTY, CASH, ORNAMENT, VEHICLES, SHARES, FIXED DEPOSITS FROM COW MAFIA SHOULD BE EXCLUSIVELY SPENT ON THE WELFARE OF THE GOSHALAS, KINE HOUSE, VETERINARY MEDICINES, GRASS CULTIVATION FOR STRAY AND DESTITUTE COW PROGENY, DEVELOPMENT OF GOCHAR LAND IN VILLAGES, PROVIDING SUBSIDY FOR INSTALLING GOBAR GAS PLANTS BY THE LOCAL FARMERS AS WELL AS GOSHALAS, FIXING PER DAY MEAL FOR THE COWS STAYING IN GOSHALAS AND FUNDING IT, PROVIDING SUFFICIENT BURIAL GROUND OF COW PROGENY, STRAY COW PROGENY WHICH ARE VULNERABLE FOR COW CHALLAN FOR COW SLAUGHTER TO BE SHIFTED TO GOSHALAS WITH PROPER FOOD AND MEDICAL FACILITY ETC
4. TAGGING OF THE COW PROGENY SHOULD BE STARTED WITH IMMEDIATE EFFECT WITHIN FIXED TIME LIMIT
5. INSTALLATION OF CCTVS MADE MANDATORY IN GOSHALAS, KINE HOUSES AND VIDEO FOOTAGE TO BE SUBMITTED TO GOVT TO GET GOVT BENEFITS AND SUBSIDIES AS IT WAS MADE IN CASE OF "NO PUC NO FUEL"

It is pertinent to mention that the money made and recovered from sale of beef which is already certified by govt during the raid by police and ED from the cow mafia; the money should be spent for the welfare of cow progeny and prevention of further generation of beef as due to misgovernance and lawlessness and insensitive law enforcement agencies for quid pro quo who allow the slaughter for the untimely death of lakhs of cow progeny should be removed from government system.

TO BEGIN WITH IF THE GOVT TRULY WANTS TO PREVENT COW CHALLAN FOR COW SLAUGHTER THEN IT SHOULD START WITH EVERY GALLI OF THE STATE AND LOCAL PS BY TAKING THE DECLARATION FROM THE PERSONS WHO KEEP COW PROGENY DO NOT EAT BEEF AND END RESULT WILL BE SOME CRIMINALS WHO ARE INTO THIS AS A BUSINESS AND SELF EMPLOYMENT FOR NO FEAR OF LAW WILL STAY AWAY WITH IMMEDIATE EFFECT.

IF THERE IS NO COW DUE TO RAMPANT COW SLAUGHTER BECAUSE OF VOTE BANK POLITICS AND HUGE AMOUNT OF CASH IN THE PROCESS OF COW CHALLAN AND EXPORT OF BEEF IN THE KNOWLEDGE OF BOTH PAST GOVERNMENT AND PRESENT GOVERNMENT IN THE STATE AND AT THE CENTER

THEN THERE WILL BE NO RELIGION CALLED HINDUISM BASED ON WHICH RSS IS IN POWER INDIRECTLY AND BJP DIRECTLY

AND SO IT IS IN YOUR FAVOUR TO STOP COW SLAUGHTER WITH IMMEDIATE EFFECT AND THOSE WHO SURVIVE ON BEEF THEY SHOULD CONSIDER IMPORTING BEEF FROM OTHER COUNTRIES BY PAYING CUSTOM DUTY AND IT WILL BE MADE CRYSTAL CLEAR WITHOUT ANY HYPOCRISY IN THE NAME OF COW THAT WHO ARE THE BEEF EATERS IN THIS COUNTRY AS THEY WILL BE DOCUMENTED BY THE GOVERNMENT DUE TO IMPORT PAPERWORK.

THERE IS NO PROHIBITION ON BEEF EATING IN OUR CONSTITUTION BUT THERE IS RESTRICTION ON ILLEGAL COW SLAUGHTER UNDER THE AGE OF 14 YEARS AND WITHOUT A VAS CERTIFICATE IN ODISHA AND SO THE BEEF EATERS SHOULD IMPORT AS PER THEIR REQUIREMENT AND IT WILL IMMEDIATELY SOLVE THE PROBLEM OF ADULTERATION OF BEEF IN THE RESTAURANTS WHICH IS A THREAT TO HINDUISM.
