VIOLATION OF COW SLAUGHTER ACT ODISHA AND COW CHALLAN INTERSTATE AND INTERDISTRICT

Sir

With due respect I want to bring to your notice regarding the above mentioned matter.

It is pertinent to mention that cow slaughter is prohibited in Odisha below the age of 14 years and any slaughter requires a veterinary doctor's fitness certificate along with a FIR filed in the local PS to make it legal as per law.

Surprisingly under RTI it is revealed that no such FIR and Fitness Certificate of VAS is available which means no lawful slaughter of cow and its progeny is done.

It is pertinent to mention that from media reports it is understood that there is regular smuggling of cows and its meat is seized by the authorities which proves the collapse of the system and no vigilant watch is kept on this unlawful trade willfully for appearament politics.

There is no systematic record of the ownership of the cows although it is protected under special Act which is not applicable to many other animals.

As the ownership of cow is not decided conclusively these animals are always at receiving end and after serving and during serving the owner they are mercilessly slaughtered unlawfully and get away from the clutches of law.

My previous representation to the concerned authorities as a compliance to the PIL is still not considered and not a single suggestion to strengthen the Act and to stop cow challan and cow slaughter is carried out till date.

Repeat reminders regarding the above matter are still suppressed by the authorities and false information is provided.

You are requested to provide FIR and Fitness Certificate of VAS of any such slaughter taken in your jurisdiction in between 2014 to 2021 specifically in Sheikh Bazaar, Mahamadia Bazaar, Alisha Bazaar, Dewan Bazaar, Odia Bazaar, Buxi Bazaar, Cantonment Road, Samaj Office, Khatbin Sahi, Sati chaura, Khan Nagar and many other places.

The authorities of Khordha District, Puri District and Ganjam District are also requested to provide the above mentioned details of FIR and Fitness Certificate of VAS of any such slaughter in between 2014 to 2021 and steps taken to prevent cow challan and cow slaughter unlawfully both inside the district, intradistrict and interstate border.

If no information is available then it is automatically proved that unlawful cow slaughter is going on and obviously it is in the knowledge of concerned local PS as such activities cannot be hidden from the eyes of the police.

Under the circumstances there is necessity of judicial intervention to appoint Special Task Force to activate the existing Act as it is done in the case of Manual Scavenging Act which was abolished but

still operational due to the willful negligence of the Government which was corrected suo motu by the Hon'ble Orissa High Court.

This email is a prerequisite of filing a fresh PIL and a compliance to the PIL guidelines.

This is in continuation to my email dated 25 04 2021 regarding violation of probihibition of cow progeny slaughter act odisha and cow challan interstate and interdistrict.

It has been proven beyond reasonable doubt that due to willful negligence of law enforcement agencies such type of containers having 58 cattle were smuggled from Begunia to Kolkata for

slaughter purpose without VAS certificate, transport clearance and in violation of all guidelines and Odisha Prohibition of cow progeny slaughter Act.

It cannot be believed that 58 big animals were captivated in a place; a big container was parked for transportation and a single police personnel could not see it or it can be assumed for quid pro quo for allowing such type of unlawful cow progeny challan.

In spite of directions from Central Government and central funding and existing ODISHA PROBIHIBITION OF COW PROGENY SLAUGHTER ACT; the Odisha state administration has not initiated the TAGGING OF COW PROGENY for identification/onus on chain of ownership of cow progeny/record of sale and purchase/record of purpose of sale and purchase/name and identity proof of all buyers and sellers/concerned officials liaisoning between buyers and sellers/record of birth and death which is required for census purpose maybe just for facilitating quid pro quo.

As already Special Task Force has been formed for stopping challan of vajrakapta, body parts and skin of tiger, leopard, elephant etc, special protection of Olive Ridley and special wings have been formed like narcotics and special desk in various PS just to focus specific problem areas so also a prayer can made in the form of PIL to form a Special Task Force to enforce the existing ODISHA PROBIHIBITION OF COW PROGENY SLAUGHTER ACT.

In spite of my repeat reminders and representations as per the direction of the Hon'ble Orissa High Court in WPC 18220/2010 disposed of on 21/01/2019; the authorities are totally defunct except providing information on false affidavit.

I want to inform you that most of stray animals as mentioned above are having problems in their mouth and feet and they are unable to eat and walk properly and facing difficulty to sleep and get up.

I have marked these symptoms since last 3-4 days and it is spreading very fast from one to another.

So under the circumstances I request you to send a medical team to this area to verify the facts and do proper medical treatment at the earliest.

The animals who are kept by individuals are also needed to be inspected and if it is a serious matter public awareness should be created and as Cuttack is full of unauthorized cow herds and proper documentation is not maintained; the authority should make visits to those slum areas like Jobra, CDA, Bidanasi, Deer park and many others for proper medical treatment and vaccination for prevention of the disease.

The concerned ward offices may be informed for about the above matter to take necessary action at the grassroot level.

Kindly treat this as urgent and initiate action immediately to further spreading of the animal disease because within 2 days I have seen the spreading from one to ten animals approx. in my locality.

## PROPOSAL FOR UID FOR COW AND THEIR PROGENY TO PROTECT THEM FROM CATTLE SMUGGLING

## NEW DELHI, APRIL 24, 2017 THE HINDU

The Centre has proposed issuing "Unique Identification Number Sequences" for cows and their progeny to protect them from cattle smuggling. The plan is the brainchild of the Union Agriculture Ministry for "tamper-proof identification of cattle using polyurethene tags with a Unique Identification Number Sequence."

"The Ministry of Agriculture has devised a method of tamper-proof identification of cattle using polyurethene tags with Unique Identification Number Sequence. This may be made mandatory for all cow and its progeny throughout India for all cattle that is owned," said a government committee report filed before a Supreme Court Bench led by Chief Justice of India J.S. Khehar on Monday.

The Committee recommended that each animal be tagged with proper records of identification details, including age, breed, sex, lactation, height, body, colour, horn type, tail switch and special marks. It said "mass-tagging" of cattle was already practised for insurance purpose.

The Committee, led by a Joint Secretary of the Ministry of Home Affairs, said it found cattle smuggling to be a "by-product" of the dairy industry.

Stray, "retired" and abandoned cattle face high risk of falling into smugglers' hands, the panel said. So, cattle smuggling should be stopped at the source, instead of on the India-Bangladesh border at the cost of the lives of BSF jawans, it said.

The government said four BSF jawans were killed and 302 injured in skirmishes with cattle smugglers over the past three years. "Dry dairy scheme could be declared a scheme of national priority," the panel suggested.

- 1. This email is a continuation of earlier email regarding unlawful cow and bull slaughter and their challan both interdistrict and interstate and the above mentioned matter is root cause and beginning of the unlawful trade as the animals are unidentified and their owners play a shadow politics like if caught they disown the animals and no case is registered and if not caught they do unlawful flesh trade which is either ways beneficial for the cow mafias active in every galli of Cuttack.
- 2. I want to file an official complaint regarding the above matter and I can identify the persons involved in the above matter and kindly treat this as my FIR.

- 3. It has become a regular habit of the cow mafias to leave the helpless very small calves who cannot stand properly and suffer from malnutrition due to lack of required mother's milk during their childhood and they take full advantage of social apathy, hypocrisy and lack of social responsibility.
- 4. These small calves are the product of the people of same galli who keep cows for milk business and as the small calves are not economically viable they leave them on the road in very inhuman manner or/and sell them to cow mafias and both ways it is viable for the people who keep cows for milk.
- 5. Under the circumstances you are requested to direct all the local PS to have help desk to maintain a register about the persons who have cows, about birth and death of cows and calves and sale and purchase of cows and calves so that the onus can be fixed and charges under animal cruelty Act can be framed and beginning of unlawful cow challan and slaughter can be traced and it is pertinent to mention that the above matter is totally coming under the jurisdiction of Home Department.
- 6. It is pertinent to mention that the direction of Hon'ble Orissa High Court in my PIL WPC 18220/2010 disposed of on 21/01/2019 are still not complied by the government and due to the willful negligence of the administration the cow mafias are getting powerful and expanding although other businesses are shrinking due to COVID 19 and it seems there is no guideline for such unlawful trade.
- 7. I request your good office to register the FIR based on my complaint under Animal Cruelty Act against the persons who abandon very small calves on the road at the mercy of nature during the peak hot summer, lockdown and shutdown and severe cyclonic rain and storm which show the degradation of humanity at least completely in my locality which are covered under CCTV.
- 8. If no relief is delivered then I have to file a fresh PIL /Contempt of Court Direction, giving false information on affidavit in the Hon'ble Orissa High Court.
- 9. As the above matter violates two central Acts as well as one Orissa State Act it needs your immediate attention and action to prohibit such type of inhumanity and injustice and they should be immediately shifted to any NGO as children are shifted to Child Helpline.
- 10. There should be a helpline for rescue of such abandoned very small calves on the road at the mercy of nature during the peak hot summer, lockdown and shutdown and severe cyclonic rain and storm.
